



Artful Eggs with Sharpie

MATERIALS:

- Sharpie Fine Point Markers, Set of 24
- Sharpie Metallic Fine Point Marker, Set of 3
- Sharpie Fine Point Markers, Black Pack of 5
- Sharpie Fine Point Markers, Set of 5, Color Burst Colors
- Sharpie Ultra-Fine Point Markers, Set of 5, Black
- Wooden Eggs
- Mini Canvas
- Creativity Street Sequin Mix, 4oz
- Aleene's Quick Dry Tacky Glue, 4oz

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS:

- Acrylic gesso/white acrylic paint
- Paint brushes
- Rubbing alcohol
- Droppers
- Clear acrylic varnish

INSTRUCTIONS:

Have fun creating simple decorations for Spring in this demo. Don't hesitate to use the techniques described below for any substrate - faux eggs, wooden balls, mini-canvas, and more are appropriate!

1. For some designs, it may be best to prime wooden egg using acrylic gesso or white acrylic paint prior to decorating with Sharpie markers and other embellishments. Allow to dry.
2. Pour sequins in to a container or tray(s) to keep them organized throughout the activity.
3. Use Sharpie markers to create designs on eggs in any theme. For example, super heroes, pop art, cartoon characters, zen doodles, mandalas, text, tie-dye blended with rubbing alcohol for marbling effect, humpty-dumpty, Spring flowers, etc.
4. Be careful not to smear or smudge your design as you work. Allow to dry as you go.
5. Use sequins to embellish eggs further, as desired. Apply craft glue using a paintbrush or wooden craft stick. Glue sequins on to egg, and allow glue to dry.
6. Once all decorated areas are dry, spray eggs with Crystal Clear Acrylic Varnish if desired. Apply a single coat at a time, in a well-ventilated area or outside.
