Twisteez Masks

Grade Levels 5-12

Note: instructions and materials based on a class of 25 students. Adjust as needed.

Process

- Prepare the mask form in one of these wavs:
 - Purchase wire strainers in a kitchen supply center. Silver wires may be spray painted black, if desired. These strainers already have handles attached, so they make great mask forms.
 - Use an old badminton racquet or child's toy racquet
 - Cut a 8" wide x 10" high oval from Wireform Diamond mesh. Place oval over a plastic face form and use fingers to press the Wireform around the facial features. Be sure to pick up all the contours around the forehead and chin. This type of mask will not have a handle.

NOTE: Wireform will produce sharp edges when cut, use caution when handling. Recommend wearing garden gloves and turning the edges of the Wireform oval over once it is cut, so that wires do not poke the face.

2. Weave the Twisteez onto the face. Secure one end to the wire with a tight loop, then bend and shape features. Include eyes, ears, mouth, ears, hair, horns...everything!

Use a variety of wire colors and shape them in interesting ways. Wires do not have to be confined to the face form - let them extend off in twists and curls!


Twisteez can be placed closely together for a solid-looking area of color.
