


# Inside Cover



Note: Each group of 10 pages is called a signature (abbreviated as “sig”).



1. Start by passing through the creased side of **sig 1, hole 1**, then through 1A. You need to leave a 4” tail on the end of the cord and tie a knot in the end so it doesn’t pass through the hole.
2. Go up through 1B and into **sig 1, hole 2**.
3. Go up through **sig 1, hole 3** to hole 1C.
4. Go up through hole 1D, then into **sig 1, hole 4**.
5. Go down through **sig 1, hole 3**, into hole 1C.
6. From 1C go through hole 1B and through **sig 1, hole 2**.
7. From **sig 1, hole 2** go to **sig 1, hole 1** and through to cover hole 2A (this is where you will start a new signature).
8. From 2A you will place your next signature (sig 2) on top of signature 1 and thread into **sig 2, hole 2**. Use the same process as the first signature, but using the second group of holes on the cover (2A-2D) and signature 2. Do the same for each signature to the corresponding number on the cover, so signature 3 would stitch to cover holes 3A-3D.
9. When you complete signature 7 take the thread from **sig 7, hole 1** through hole 7A, and then down through 1B (from the outside to the inside) of the cover. Do not go through any of the signature holes, just the cover holes. Then from the inside cover going to the outside go through 1C. From there push into the cover from the outside through hole 7D.

10. From hole 7D wrap the cord along the folded edge of the signatures and push your cord through **sig 1, hole 4**, then take your cord down the crease of signature 1 and tie a knot to the tail of the cord you started with.
